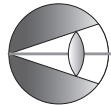

Director's Notes

The culture from "South of the Border" is a vibrant one, indeed. Native American, African, and European influences come together, making an exciting musical experience. The richness of rhythm and poetry leaves us tapping our feet and swooning to the music's passion.

The featured work for the concert is the Misa Criolla by Ariel Ramírez. This challenging work is one of the most popular pieces performed by choral groups today. The composition of the Misa Criolla was motivated by the Second Vatican Council (1962) which, for the first time, allowed the saying of the mass in the language of the people. Ramírez's response was to write a work based on traditional Latin American dances and songs. This mass is a vital mixture of the time-honored tradition of the Catholic Church and the joy and passion of Latin American folk music.

Ramírez is also well-known for the solo piece, "Alfonsina y el Mar" (Alfonsina and the Sea). This song was written as a memorial to the well-loved Argentine poet, Alfonsina Storni who, dramatically, committed suicide by walking into the sea.

Probably the composer most well known to American audiences is Heitor Villa Lobos. The "Ave Verum" and "Panis Angelicus" are sacred twentieth century settings in the traditional Latin. The passion of the text comes through dramatically in the music. Also on the program is a setting for piano and voice of the famous "Bachianas Brasileiras No. 5", a lovely portrayal of the beauty of an Argentinean evening.

The Latin love of nature is well represented in pieces such as "Mañanitas de mi Tierra" (Mornings of my Land) a Costa Rican piece by Julio Fonseca and "Alma Llanera" (Soul of the Plains), a popular folk song set for choir by Pedro Gutiérrez. Of course we also find passionate Latin love in many pieces such as "Bullerengue" which is named for a — *CONTINUED* →

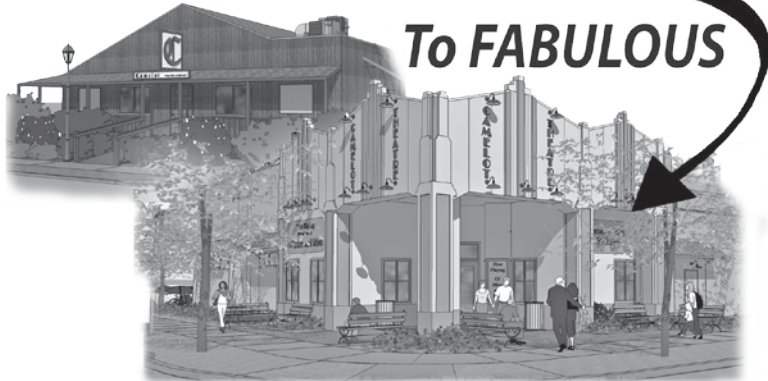

Colombian dance and “Yo le Canto Todo el Dia” (I Sing to You All Day) from Venezuela. But we also find a metaphorical combination of the two in the very touching “Manchai Puito” (Two Little Doves), arranged by Oscar Escalda, in which one dove relates to the other that she has “cut her wings” for the sake of the love of one “false one” and now will die from the disappointment of rejection.

Three pieces exult exclusively in the rhythm of the dance. “Verano Porteño” (Summer in Buenos Aires) by famous tango composer Astor Piazzolla, uses nonsense syllables to represent the sounds of the tango, while “La Lluvia” (The Rain), written by American composer Stephen Hatfield, is based on a panpipe melody from Ecuador. Finally, the well-known “Mas Que Nada”, by Sergio Mendez of “Brazil ‘66” fame, tells of the dancer who will not be kept from dancing the samba.

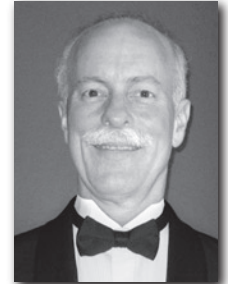

He was also the music director for numerous musical theatre productions including *Into the Woods*, *The King and I*, and *Fiddler on the Roof*.

Mr. Reppert is now an active musician in the Rogue Valley. As music director at Camelot Theater he has worked on productions of *Cabaret*, *Secret Garden*, *Gigi* and *White Christmas*. He also has worked as a singer and accompanist for the Rogue Valley Chorale. He accompanies the Jefferson State Choral Coalition, under the direction of Kirby Shaw, and works as a musician in many other capacities around the Valley.

Mikiko S. Petrucelli - Accompanist

Born in Tokyo, Japan, Mikiko S. Petrucelli first started playing piano at the age of 4. She attended the Mushashino Academia Musicae and received her undergraduate degree in Piano Performance. She then moved to Germany and earned a Performance Degree from Hochschule für Musik, Detmold in Detmold, Germany. After she returned to Japan, Mikiko played with the string chamber group Uovo as their guest pianist, touring Japan and giving chamber and solo concerts in Germany. She has played on NHK radio, the national public radio station in Japan, and won a special award at the Josef Dichter Competition in Vienna, Austria in 2001.



Mikiko moved to the United States in 2004 and received a Masters of Music from Baylor University and Doctorate of Musical Arts in Piano Performance from the University of Nebraska, Lincoln.

In 2008, as a result of winning the Chiara Competition, Mikiko performed Dvorak's Piano Quintet with the Chiara Quartet. She also has studied Historical Performance Practice in fortepiano. In 2008, she was invited to an international conference, the result being a full Hixson-Lied Presentation of Scholarly and Creative Activity Grant. She attended an international conference "The Art of the Fortepiano" and performed in several concerts in Middleburg, the Netherlands.

Mikiko has extensive experience as a chamber and solo pianist and also as an accompanist. As of May 2010, she completed three years of service at Doane College in Crete, Nebraska as an adjunct faculty member. She recently relocated to the Rogue Valley and is in her first season as accompanist for the Siskiyou Singers.
