

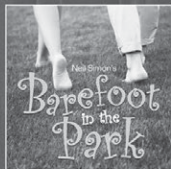

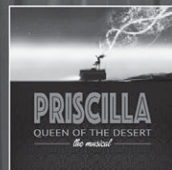

## Director's Notes

There is a long, highly learned tradition in the performance of black spirituals. Spirituals are not a kitschy backwater of music; they are central to the music of America and the world. Truly, we have been singing black music all our lives. Anyone who sings a Beatles song or a jazz standard sings a piece firmly rooted in the music of the slaves from so long ago. As Anton Armstrong, the director of the St. Olaf Choir, says, "In the twenty-first century, these slaves' songs transcend any one race of people and have become a universal musical expression of people seeking release from whatever personal or societal oppression enslaves us. They provide us with an inspiring treasury of song filled with the human exploration of pain, pathos, hope, courage, faith, and freedom."

We are very lucky to have two very distinguished members of the national music community with us today. and first person narratives of the spirituals we will be singing. Dr. Guenther holds degrees from the University of Kansas and the Catholic University of America. She is currently the professor of church music at Wesley Theological Seminary in Washington DC.

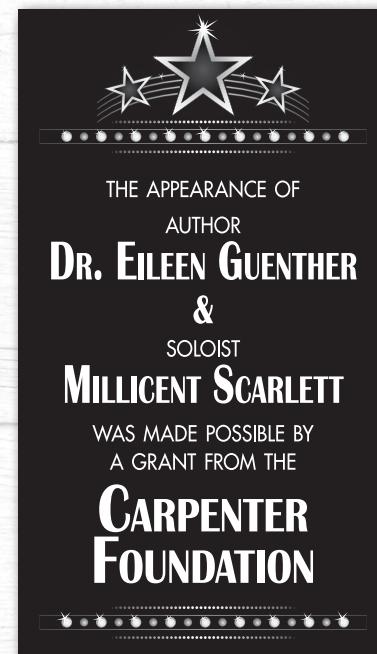
We also have soprano and spirituals expert Millicent Scarlett with us. Millicent was a part of the Washington National Cathedral's "God's Gonna Trouble the Waters" concert, which was in celebration of the opening of the Smithsonian's National Museum of African American History and Culture. She has been the winner of numerous awards, and scholarships, most notably as a winner of the Luciano Pavarotti International Competition as a National Semi-finalist at the Metropolitan Opera Auditions in New York.

Finally, the North Medford High School Concert Choir will be joining us. This award-winning high school group is directed by a rising star of the Rogue Valley, Kendra Taylor. Kendra is in her second year as director and also had starring roles at Camelot Theatre and with Livia Genise Productions.

Our concert contains spirituals with a wide range of emotions and styles. There are classic arrangements by such notables as William Dawson and Jester Hairston and more contemporary approaches represented by André Thomas, Rosephanye Powell, and Moses Hogan.

Dr. Guenther writes, "To my mind, Spirituals are among the most powerful music ever created. Spirituals are universal; they apply to situations well outside of slavery. I have long felt that, as Arthur Jones writes, Spirituals are 'available to all persons who are prepared to open themselves to the unsettling healing power that inhabits these marvelous songs of life.' They come out of slavery, indisputably deeply meaningful, archetypically human experiences, relevant not only to the specific circumstances of slavery but also to women and men struggling with issues of justice, freedom, and spiritual wholeness in all times and places."

Our choir is humbled by the vast power and beauty of the pieces that we present to you in this concert. We hope that this performance fills you with the sense of hope, beauty, and strength this music offers our world today.

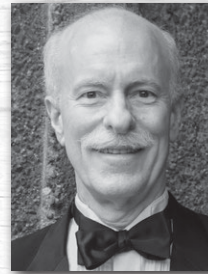

## Biographies

### Mark Reppert - Music Director



Mr. Mark Reppert studied conducting, composition, piano, and music history at the University of Southern California, graduating with a degree in Music History. He received a master's degree in Piano Performance from California State University, Chico, graduating with distinction. He soloed with the Shasta Symphony as the winner of the Shasta Symphony Solo Competition and also with the Paradise Symphony as well as performed numerous solo recitals.

Mr. Reppert began his teaching career in California in 1975. He taught all manner of music from kindergarten to adult, including band, orchestra, elementary music, college music appreciation, community choir, and high school and middle school choir. Moving to Oregon in 1998, Mr. Reppert was the director of choral music at North Medford High School. The award-winning choirs were an important part of the musical community, performing in many venues including the annual Renaissance Dinner. Mr. Reppert also served as music director for numerous musical theatre productions at North including *Into the Woods*, *The King and I*, and *Fiddler on the Roof*.

Mr. Reppert retired from teaching in 2008 and is now an active musician in the Rogue Valley. He has served as music director at the Camelot Theater (*Sweeney Todd*, *Cabaret*, *Gypsy*, *Les Misérables*) and accompanist throughout the valley. He is also a choral adjudicator for both middle school and high school choir competitions.

Mr. Reppert is in his ninth year as the director of Siskiyou Singers. During his tenure, the choir has performed many major works such as the *Christmas Oratorio* of Bach, the *Chichester Psalms* of Leonard Bernstein, and the *Maria Theresa Mass* of Haydn. Siskiyou Singers has also presented world premieres of three works by local composers. Mark is thrilled to be a part of this fine organization.

## Mikiko S. Petrucelli Accompanist

**M**ikiko S. Petrucelli was born in Tokyo, Japan, where she first started playing piano at the age of 4. She attended the Mushashino Academia Musicae and received her undergraduate degree in Piano Performance. She then moved to Germany and earned a Performance Degree from Hochschule für Musik, Detmold in Detmold, Germany.

After she returned to Japan, Mikiko played with the string chamber group Uovo as their guest pianist, touring Japan and giving chamber and solo concerts in Germany. She has played on NHK radio, the national public radio station in Japan, and won a special award at the Josef Dichter Competition in Vienna, Austria in 2001.

In 2004 Mikiko moved to the United States and received a Masters of Music from Baylor University and Doctor of Musical Arts in Piano Performance from the University of Nebraska, Lincoln.

In 2008, as a result of winning the Chiara Competition, Mikiko performed Dvořák's Piano Quintet with the Chiara Quartet. She has also studied Historical Performance Practice in fortepiano. In 2008, she was invited to an international conference, as a result of a complete Hixson-Lied Presentation of Scholarly and Creative Activity Grant. She attended an international conference, "The Art of the Fortepiano," and performed in several concerts in Middleburg, the Netherlands.

Mikiko has extensive experience as a chamber and solo pianist as well as an accompanist. As of May of 2010, she completed three years of service at Doane College in Crete, Nebraska as an adjunct faculty member. Mikiko is in her eighth season as accompanist for the Siskiyou Singers.

## Millicent Scarlett Soprano

**D**escribed as a "juicy tone" by the Baltimore Sun, soprano soloist Millicent Scarlett, who hails from Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada, continues to display her artistic and musical artistry on the recital, orchestral and operatic stage. She has been the winner of numerous awards and scholarships, most notably the Luciano Pavarotti International Competition as a winner, and a National Semi-finalist at The Met. She is currently preparing for a series of recital and public appearances in the DMV area. Millicent is an Adjunct Professor of Voice, and the vocal facilitator at George Washington University.

### Dr. Eileen Guenther Author



**A**s Professor of Church Music at Wesley Theological Seminary, Dr. Eileen Guenther teaches music and worship courses and is Director of Chapel Music. She leads workshops on music and social justice, global music, Spirituals, and clergy-music relations. Her book, *Rivals or a Team: Clergy-Musician Relationships in the 21st Century* (2012), has received a great deal of media attention, with interviews in a variety of blogs and denominational newsletters, *The Huffington Post*, and *The Christian Century*. A second book, *In Their Own Words: Slave Life and the Power of Spirituals* (2016), has received a similar enthusiastic response. Since its publication, she has given over 30 presentations combining Spirituals, first-person narratives and her commentary throughout the country.

Eileen holds degrees from the University of Kansas and The Catholic University of America. She served six years as National President of the American Guild of Organists, the third woman to lead this organization since its founding in 1896. As an organ recitalist Eileen has performed over 250 recitals in the USA, Europe, Asia, Africa, and South America. She served as visiting lecturer at Africa University in Zimbabwe, has taught in Uganda and Ivory Coast and she has led eight groups of Wesley Seminary students on immersion trips to South Africa.

Dr. Guenther served with distinction as Director of Music at St. Francis Episcopal Church in Potomac, MD and as Minister of Music and Liturgy at Foundry United Methodist Church in Washington, DC. — BIOGRAPHIES CONTINUED —>
